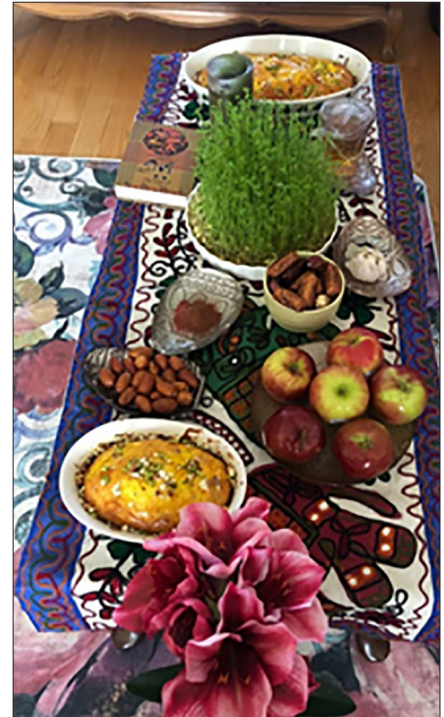
## Persian Ministry

The Persian Church that has joined with the Pilgrim Community Church's Mosaic Multiethnic Ministry has altered Sunday meetings to online meetings.

On January 14th, N(S) and F had their refugee hearing and were accepted as refugees of Canada by the grace of God. F has been diligently sharing the Good News to his friends in Iran. One of his friends H has become an online member of the church and is being nurtured through WhatsApp. Please pray for Sister N's health and so that F's father, who is back in Iran, can come to Canada.

On February 18th, A and N, who have been consistently training since last summer, were baptized. Please pray for the two, that their faith will continuously grow with no fear in their hearts.

On March 19th, N(A) invited friends to a small party to celebrate Nowruz, which is the Persian New Year day. ## Southern Baptist Korean Church Leaders Vision Tour

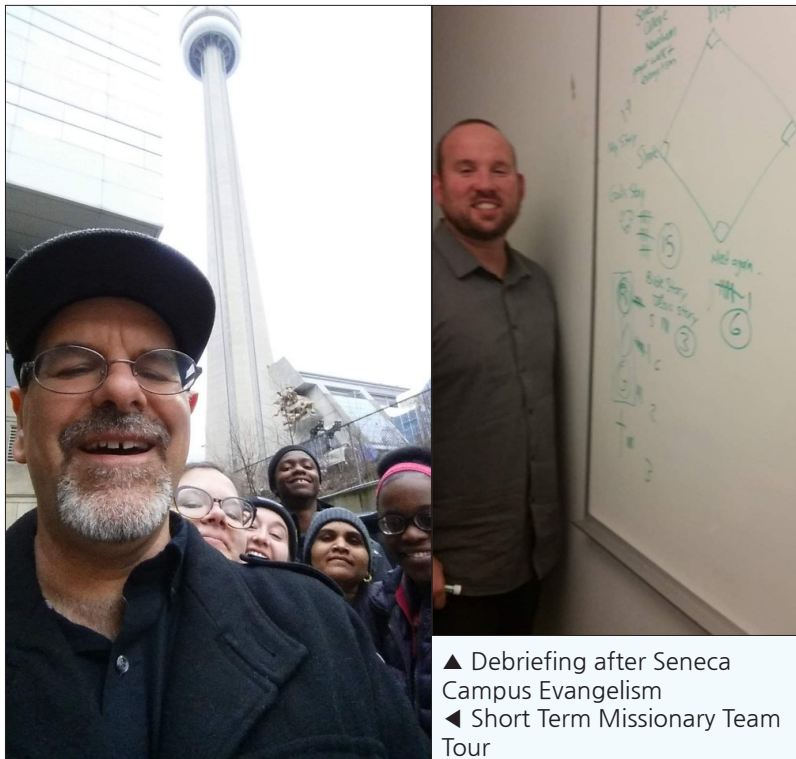
