Due to Covid-19, every church is facing unprecedent difficult times. As such, we are delaying or cancelling planned events, and are unable to have normal worship service in person. During this challenging time, the church should remember the living voice of the Lord and the word of God's truth written in the Bible.

Just as Jesus revealed that he was the Christ through his crucifixion and resurrection, when we die to ourselves and this world, and live to God only, we will be disclosed in history as the body of Christ overcoming and reigning over all things. I am convinced that our God is carrying on His work of building up the glorious church against which the gates of hell shall not prevail under any challenges.

In order for our generation to greet the returning Lord as the last church in the end times, every believer, who consists of basic unit in the church, must be equipped both as follower of Jesus Christ and as church planter who the Lord can build up His body upon their confession of faith in Him.

When we start to live out our lives as God's mission in response to various respective needs of people in our whole city with the Spirit of God beyond our ecclesial individualism and denominationalism, we can see a living body of Christ in our every village and every town.

With this vision and direction for multiethnic mosaic ministry, the BLESS team keeps praying and going beyond Korean diaspora so that every believer in every ethnic church can be equipped together as evangelists, disciple-makers, and church planters.

In addition to weekly meeting for

training on Monday evening, on the third Saturday of June, 20 members of Mosaic Outreach Team went to the East York area where many Bengali people live, to care and pray for people and share the gospel.

With a vision of mobilizing local churches to missions, furthermore, every Thursday evening we are having prayer meetings for the multiethnic mosaic ministry, every ethnic church, and the salvation of the unsaved souls. We believe that this ministry of prayer is the engine of our mosaic ministry.

On June 20th, H and F whom we have shared the Good News and nurtured every week by online have been baptized. The Good News brought peace to H and this changed his life, and through his new life, his wife, F was also able to have faith. Please pray that God protects this family even within Iran's hostile circumstances towards the Good News, and that this family can be built up into a strong church.

I also request prayer for Samah, who came to Canada as a refugee due to brutal genocide towards Yazidi people by Daesh(ISIS). Let God be delightedly accept her heart and confession in response to the Good News and work out among her family and relatives to react to the Good News. Please pray that through these people, the Yazidi will have their own church here.

Although the pandemic is continuing to affect every aspect of our lives, let us have faith in the Lord who will lead and complete history as exactly as He said already in the Scriptures. With this faith in the Lord over all things, let us move forward. Maranatha!
