8. Please show your favor and grace to my mother in Korea who is rehabilitating so that she can recover quickly and see you after this pandemic!

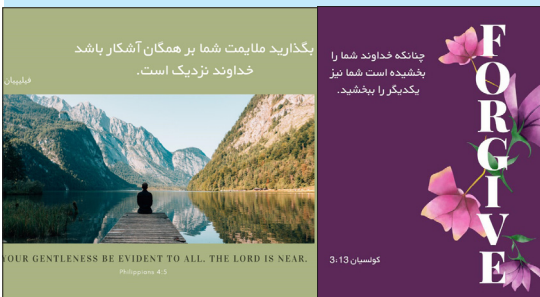
Greetings of peace from Toronto, a multiethnic city in North America.

2020 was a year when some people around us passed away of COVID-19, and many of the existing missions were restricted and not carried out. Even the event that I was trying to do online was not successful because of the lockdown. In the meantime, we are launching a ministry on Facebook to find out more seekers who desire to know about Jesus and the gospel by creating pages that bless people of all races and uploading the Bible verses or Christian films through paid advertisements. When a Persian sister who is good at designing creates a Farsi and English Bible verse that touched her heart and posts them on Facebook, this will be used to promote with a chosen target audience. It will cost promotional expenses, but it is a ministry that seeks to establish online relationships with people who post comments or messages, and to share the gospel and nurture them. Please pray that the team is well organized and that the funds needed for online ministry are regularly collected.
