Make Disciples of All Nations with the Good News of God

What is the mission? Whose mission are we talking about as we speak about the mission? The misunderstanding of God's mission is not a small thing because it is directly related to the misunderstanding of God Himself. The current discourses of the missional church are based upon our reflections on the reduced understanding of God's mission into a cross-cultural ministry focusing on evangelism and church planting. The success and failure of the 21st-century church of Christ lie in that we are not losing the ultimate nature of evangelism by the complete understanding and practice of the Great Commission of our Lord who said, "make disciples of all nations," while standing for the holistic nature of God's mission.

The Gospel of God is the Good News that God's pleasing will reveal in a form of a promise that has been decisively fulfilled through Jesus Christ in history. The reign of God will be ultimately completed in history through our discipleship life of

accepting Jesus Christ, who has fulfilled all of God's will, as the Lord in our hearts and lives to follow Jesus Christ in every concrete area of our life. The Gospel of God's Kingdom calls us not only to repent and to believe but also to respond to Jesus' calling, "Follow me!" That is why the Great Commission in Matthew 28:18-20 given to the followers of Jesus is condensed into the command, "make disciples of all nations!" with the main verb. All other commands in particle form of "going," "baptizing," and "teaching to obey" tell the followers of Jesus about the ways to make disciples of all nations.

Now our times of diaspora mission is where God has brought all the nations from the ends of the

earth beside us. How can we go to all nations, baptize and teach them to obey all commands of Jesus in this new context of missions? All the nations are beside us if we cross over our doorstep. Who can go to the nations? Who can baptize the nations? Who can teach the nations to obey the Lord? It is the ones who follow Jesus. It is all of the faithful ones who are born again by the very Gospel, everyone who responds rightly to the Gospel with repentance, faith, and discipleship life. All believers should share the Good News of God, that is, what is our hope in life, what is our faith in the coming Kingdom of God, within God-provided precious encounters in the concrete contexts of our life throughout our being, life, and witness.

Are we knowing and enjoying the whole Gospel of God today? The contemporary church is the only church that the Gospel has geographically reached to all the nations in the church history of two thousand years. But there would not be any other churches

as much as the Gospel has weakened and reduced in the contemporary church. The whole Gospel as the Good News about the Reign of God throughout all areas of life can be realized in the world only by the whole church that lives out the life of Christ Jesus in our fields of life with the Holy Spirit. Without the life of discipleship of all believers in their own concrete fields of life, the whole Gospel is simply a theory rather than the power and wisdom of God to save all who believe. The Great Commission of our Lord Jesus Christ that commands us to go the nations and to make disciple of all

nations is the lifestyle that all churches and believers must recover again in the end times.

Jesus Christ walked on the dusty roads of Palestine, proclaimed the Gospel of God's Kingdom, made disciples of the repenting and believing ones, and commissioned the same mission of him to their community of faith. This very Jesus Christ is dwelling in us as new life. When we follow this lifestyle of Jesus Christ he will expose himself with the power of God's Reign in our place of life and all of our relationships today. It will be done through us who continuously go to the

nations beside us, proclaim the Gospel of God's Kingdom to every one of the nations we encounter, baptize all of the nations who repent and believe so that they are united to the death and resurrection of Lord Jesus, and teach them to obey all of the words of the Lord from the words of the Lord's Great Commission. I wish all of us can respond to this glorious calling to make disciples of all nations so that the Gospel is internalized from our knowledge to our heart, and incorporated into daily life from our heart to our hands and feet. ADAM HOUSE MINISTRIES

Our world is currently experiencing the largest displacement crisis of our era. Driven by the Syrian civil war and conflicts in South Sudan, Central African Republic and Central America, the number of people forced to flee their homes is rising every day. To escape violence, families leave behind everything. Millions of families are arriving in refugee camps

with nothing or struggling in poor housing. Now there are around eleven to twelve refugee shelters in Toronto. Having nothing and knowing no one is just the beginning of the barriers refugees face. Above all, refugee claimants have language barriers. They are dealing with numerous issues-trauma that was experienced in their home country and on their journey to

Canada, and often living with the anguish of leaving family behind.

Adam House in the Toronto downtown area provides refugee claimants with clean and safe living accommodations. We provide assistance and advice with immigration procedures, primarily to its residents and former residents. We provide referrals to legal services, medical assistance, and commu-

nity resources. But Adam House is much more than shelter or the services we provide. Adam House is home. A place where residents find friendship and support from our staff and each other. Adam House is also a place where refugee claimants can find hope for their future, as we pray with them through their difficulties, and celebrate their successes.

We at Adam House Ministries are working together to bring the Gospel to refugees in Toronto. We live out the love of Christ by providing compassionate care of education and housing to refugees to Canada. We carry out this task in active partnership with churches, individuals and like-minded agencies. Together we grow into the people and the followers of Christ

that we all strive to be. Together we help transform the lives of refugees in Canada.

Adam House Ministries started in the honor of Salah & Shaline Adam. Salah and Shaline Adam and their two children, Joshua (4) and Rebecca (17 months), were Arab World Ministries (AWM) workers in Toronto. The Adam's family were travelling to Sudan to celebrate the wedding of Salah's sister, and to visit refugee camps there. They boarded the Egypt Air Flight 990 when it went down on October 31, 1999, killing all 217 people on board. Hundreds of people whose lives had been touched by their compassionate ministry mourned this tragic loss.

Shaline and Salah were married in 1993 and together ministered in

Toronto with AWM. Their warm hospitality and genuine love impacted many newly arrived Canadians. As they helped find jobs and places to live, taught English and led Bible studies, the vision of establishing a refugee house in Toronto grew in their hearts.

Adam House was launched in their honour and to the glory of God on September 22, 2002.

Since January 2021, CMCA has joined Adam House Ministries for vision of multiplying ethnic church planting. We are taking part in Adam House Transitional Housing at 15 Silence Hill in North York, and along with the local churches and Interserve Canada Ministry Team we are taking care of the refugee claimers and having fellowship with them as well as sharing the Gospel through Discovery Bible Study at the Adam House North. Through the Adam House Ministries, please pray that we can be good friends to the refugee claimers and help them to be saved, leading to ethnic church planting through our sharing of the Gospel of God with our being, doing and telling.

London Yazidi Church: Inaugural Service



I thank God for His grace and praise Him whom led us to establish a Yazidi church in London, Ontario.

The 14th of March in 2021 when I had a worship Him with 8 Yazidis after 11 years since my wife and I had left our homeland after receiving His call, with a deep impression, will be remembered in my heart for a long time. All nine team members who are serving with us also had a moment of bliss. Our next mission is to preach the Gospel to roughly 600 other Yazidis in London, as well as to nurture and train them to be disciples of Christ. So, I dream that next generation of leaders are built among them and the Gospel goes beyond London and proclaims to all people in the world. I believe that we will continue to overcome

thanks to the guidance of the Holy Spirit within us although we are still deficient and undergoing trial and error.

Our church is currently worshipping both in English and Arabic. God prepared Haifa the interpreter at the best time and sent us her from Mississauga to London. Last Sunday, on March 21st, Alan who is one of founding members attended Sunday service, especially with his family, and all the team members gained strength and courage as they admire God's amazing plan and guidance.

Just a few months ago, we planned to set up a community center in London for cultural exchanges such as English, music, and art and, while praying, waited that the community center could

serve as a bridge to build a church. Surprisingly, God has responded more abundantly than we asked for. We, now, want to do our best to bring our hearts together, fix our

eyes on Him alone, serve the congregation with the love of Christ, humility, and meekness, and preach the Gospel to those who do not know our Lord.

We praise the Lord who has guided us so far and His grace that leads us continuously in the best way yet, and give all the glory only to our God.

1. For all the team members and the congregation to be one in His love,
2. For the faith of the congregation to be deeply rooted and grow right,

The CMCA is willing to put in practice the vision and strategy of reverse mission, through the diaspora missions, to accomplish the remaining task of world mission. The CMCA focuses on the ethnic church planting multiplication movement among the groups of unreached people in North America.

And more people mobilize the Thursday prayer meeting to bring prayer for a revival of prayer. 3. God provides all strength, wisdom, and finance for the accomplishment of Bangladeshis — Mamin, Philip, and Chinmoi and Persians — Nahid and John the participants in a two-year educational program for fostering ethnic church ministers and Mosaic missionaries in cooperation with Gateway Seminary and Harvest Connection and leads each of them to start their ministries as pastoral interns and missionaries. Canada Mosaic College for the Mosaic missions will be established in Toronto eventually. And many multiethnic Mosaic workers will raise in Ottawa through the six-week Friendship First Course (Ottawa Korean Church) that begins May 11th.

4. Vietnamese church (Tim), Thai church (Witthaya), Burmese church (Solomon), Arabic Holy Spirit church (Ehsan), Nepalese

church (Peter), Congolese church (Emmanuel), Bengali church (Byron), Pakistani/Indian Leaf church (Robin), Persian Parss church (Vahid), KoreanChinese church (Seongmu Cheong), Zimbabwean church (Stephen), Indian church (Sam John), Eritrean church (Minassie), Ethiopian church (Mebratu), Arabic Bible Church (Richard), Living Word Church (Henock) have the vision of the Kingdom Multiplication Movement and planting ethnic church in each city. Please build good leadership for the Thai Church. Give a full recovery for Zimbabwean pastor Stephen from a stroke. Give a full recovery for Tibetan Caleb from a spinal operation. And save the parents of Ehsan Jaro (Lewis & Souad) and keep them healthy. God helps us find churches that can cooperate with

the Eritrean Church, the Ethiopian Church (Mebratu, Henock), and the Parss Church that look for places to gather.
