Invest Your Life to the Eternity

Today many problems and pains in this world are cries of our souls, that has lost our meaning of existence and our place of being called from God. When we tune our direction in life again to the One God who called us into being in this weary and tough field of life, the grace overcoming and reigning over all things will be poured upon us from the eternal God who is here now with us. How can we live a meaningful life linking to eternity and praise God's grace in a complicated reality seemingly happened by accidents for the short numbers of year in our life?

The Good News of God is a joyful fulfillment of the covenant that the eternal God has accomplished all the eternal purpose of His creation as foreshadowed and promised in advance in this one person who has come as one among us in history. It is because the transformation in life will be started from every single soul who keels down before the Holy Spirit of truth and asks, "What am I really believing?" and "Is this Good News I believe true?" without considering the faith of their church or pastor as theirs.

Christian maturity of forming the image of Christ lies in putting discipleship life in practice to willingly deny ourselves in depending on the Holy Spirit in order to follow the model of Jesus' life. It is because we can practically enter mortification of

ourselves and the resurrection life of Christ as much as we desire to intercede between God and the lost as the ambassadors of Christ in this broken world and to convey the message of reconciliation of God to the broken one. When we do all things for the salvation of the lost by daily following the lifestyle of Jesus, the tuned life to the value of the coming eternal Kingdom of God can be formed. So, we cannot separate our discipleship life as a member of the body of Christ to share the Gospel with the lost from our spiritual maturity to grow unto the image of the Lord.

Even in our generation we need the people of God who fully invested their very temporal lives to the eternity according to the life of heroes of faith written in the Bible. In our times God is bringing people of the ends of the earth in enmity with Him to the fields of life of all believers.

In these enormous needs and opportunities, are we, the church entrusted with the Good News in the last day, fully and unregretfully investing our power, resources, and time to eternity? I wish we the church can be awaken by a word of Jim Elliot who ended his 29-year short life in a foreign country in the 20th century: "He is no fool who gives what he cannot keep to gain that which he cannot lose."

HOPE NEPALI CHURCH TORONTO Pastor Anmol

My name is Anmol, which means precious. Obviously, in the eyes of the Lord!

I was born in Hindu conservative family, but I received Jesus Christ as my Savior in an Orphanage home where I grew up. After dedicating my life to Jesus, I went for theological study in Korea and eventually ended in Canada to pursue Master's in Theology.

Once I came to Toronto, I learnt that there are more than 7,500 Nepalese people in Ontario, whereas very few Christians. Nepal is a small country located in the Himalayas, where the main religion is Hindu and Buddhist. Nepalese people in Canada are more devoted to



their religion, culture and tradition than in Nepal itself. Definitely, as everyone, Nepalese in GTA are also lost far away from Christ, and sadly, there is no one to reach out to them. I also found that I am the only theology student in GTA from Nepalese background. I got assured for the reason behind God brining me in this great city. If not me then who will



reach out to them? After finishing my seminary, I started making connection and relation with Nepalese people and with prayers decided to plant a church.

In 2020 Oct, we started gathering in my apartment in Scarborough for home fellowship.

In May 2021, we dedicated our service as a Church, and started meeting online in Zoom.

Initially, our focus was on Scarborough area, however, because of online service people from different locations started to attend and became the members of our Church. Therefore, now we are praying and looking for a location which is convenient for everyone from

Mississauga, Brampton, York, Toronto and Scarborough.

Praise the Lord, even in this pandemic, in August we could meet in person for service and BBQ.

In the season of Christmas, we could share some Gifts and Nepali Tracts in the local hood.

YAY!! Also, we could gather for Christmas celebration on 26th December. Thank God no one got Covidpositive.

We are glad and thankful that God is adding numbers in our service every week and also helping us to grow together in Christ.

Church Underground Pastor Sam John

Sam John's parents are originally from South India and moved to Saudi Arabia. Pastor Sam was born during that time. His parents built an underground church in Saudi Arabia. Twenty five years later, they came back to India and he studied and worked there. After his marriage, he stayed in Bahrain for three years, then immigrated to Canada in 2009. For three years, they prayed for church planting. In 2017 He started "Church Underground". The name was in memory of his parents' underground churches and in his indie underground music band. "My Experience at Gospel Conversations Training" Eunha Lee(Vaughan Community Church)



Gospel Conversations Training @ Willowdale Baptist Church

I participated in the Gospel conversation training held at the Willowdale Baptist Church on February 26th. The reason why I participated is that I wanted to know and learn what "Gospel conversation Training" is about. As soon as I entered the place, I was amazed to see lots of multicultural people sitting on the table for the training. Then I came to realize that regardless of culture and race, the Gospel is the same and powerful.

First, at the beginning of the training, we learned to understand and realize the heart of God.

After that, I received 4.1.1. training which is a simple discipleship training method. This 4.1.1. training focuses on teaching 4 questions using 1 piece of paper and training a disciple within 1 hour. The four questions are as below:

1)Why do we need to make disciples? 2)Who do we need to make disciples? 3)What do we share?

4)When do we make disciples?

The purpose of this training was about living a life that multiplies discipleships so that everywhere we go we will be able to witness the kingdom of God.

Although this training took place with

in the name of Jesus Christ.

Finally, it was time to go outreach to put what I had learned all morning into practice. The leaders of the host paired the participants two by two, and most of them became partners with brothers and sisters they had never seen before and were sent to evangelism around Young & Finch area. I became a partner with a very young Canadian man and was impressed by this partner who was in his early 20s. What made him want to be here on Saturday afternoon instead of hanging out with his friends? Of course, there was only one reason we all know. It was very challenging to see such a young man with a faith and passion for evangelism.

As we prayed together and finally walked outside the roads, I was still afraid to ring the doorbells of strangers' houses but soon after Jesus gave me courage and confidence. In fact, I became proud of myself and felt so honored to spread the good news.

Also, having such a faithful partner was a huge support and I got to learn a lot from him.

However, most people's reaction to the

different races and cultures, it was such a precious event where all the participants had a passion sharing for and learning

Gospel was that it was needlessly stupid and unnecessary to them and they only saw us as quite unpleasant and annoying strangers.

I felt as if the precious name of Jesus Christ had fallen to the ground and was despised, so it was so sad to see the reality. This broke my heart not because they refused me but because they refused God. This sadness was so great inside of me that I could feel my God was greatly hurt as well. It was the moment that I realized my God has given me such a precious name Jesus which seems foolish to others but I received it as a free gift when I don't deserve it at all.

What has been most beneficial to me through this training is that I have a clear purpose and reason to become a disciplemaking disciple. The purpose of my life is to become a messenger of the Gospel and longing for the life of being sent by God. Now I am very much looking forward to seeing the great works of God and experiencing a life of witnessing his amazing work on people.

With all my heart, I praise my God for being my King!

Mosaic City Missionary Certification Course News

Canada Mosaic Christian Alliance (CMCA) is conducting various missional education and training for diaspora ministries under the name of Canada Mosaic College. Among them, the 'Mosaic Urban Mis-

sionary Certificate Course', which started its first semester in cooperation with Tyndale University's Intercultural Ministries Centre in the fall of 2021 last year, is now in its second semester as of January.

Two courses (Mission course, Bible course) are opened each semester. In the first semester, we learned what it means to live as God's people and, through the new paradigm for missions suggested by the mission course and Paul's Romans, we realized that He gives us the opportunity to participate in His plan in the same way.

This second semester, in order to live out what we learned last semester, we have the 'Kingdom Life Basics' mission course, as well as the 'New Testament by Author'

course, which explores the way the 8 authors of the 27 New Testament books encountered Jesus and invites us to follow in their footsteps.

In particular, we are learning various proven methods such as the three-circle method, which only requires a pen and paper, and the Training for Trainers program, which we can use to reach out to everyone we meet, sharing the Gospel to those who do not believe, and the vision to those who already believe.

In addition, we are conducting a Bible study that is more intuitive than based on theory, so that all these tools are used only by the Gospel and the power of the Holy Spirit, not as a means of revealing our righteousness. And because of this, trainees are encouraged to accomplish these words of God one by one, starting with small things in their daily lives.

A total of 30 people, including the trainees who have completed the first semester and new trainees, are forming a unified community with which

they learn and share each week. This training course is not a onetime program, and we plan to hold a retreat and follow-up meetings after completing the lecture to become a community that continues to cooperate for the Grater Toronto Area's urban mission. On May 8th and 19th, seminars will be held to introduce opportunities for us to serve as urban missionaries alongside organizations such as Interserve, SIM, and Global Gates.

A graduation ceremony for those who have completed the one-year Urban Mosaic missionary certification course will be held on June 4th at Tyndale Chapel. We ask for the church to pray that these first-time graduates can wholly devote themselves to leading various urban missions.

Canada Mosaic College 12

Gospel Conversations Training One-day Seminar

1-day mission education and training program that provides 8 hours of education, training, and practice to help the believers begin the life of a disciple in the living fields, including direct outreach. Presenting the vision of the Kingdom Multiplication movement, 4 1 1 training, outreach, Discovery Bible study, etc., to equip every believer to begin the life of the Kingdom of God

e3(ecclesia everywhere everyday) Training

5 days a week of missional education and training that equips all members of the local church to live a discipleship life in the field of life as a missional church. Train them to hold together a 3/3 process of an ecclesia meeting in which they read the Gospels together one chapter a day, record the Gospel discipleship life in the S.O.W.E.R. journal form, and reflect together on the reading of the Gospels and the practice of life together 5 days a week. Online/Offline

AS ME Mission School

A 5-week mission education program for local churches to help the believers find the mission according to their own uniqueness, which includes stories from the Frontier Mission Stories and small group sharing through reading the Cape Town Commitment to help the believers reflect and dedicate themselves to continuing to write their life stories from God's mission perspective. By helping us live an authentic, sustainable, meaningful, and empowering life, we discover for ourselves what mission God is planning through the course of our life.

Mosaic Ministries Exposure

1-Day mission education and training program that introduces local churches through a 3-hour seminar on 21st century diaspora urban missions

DBS(DISCOVERY BIBLE STUDY) Training

A 4-week training to learn and master the Discovery Bible Study in which all the members of the local church learn from each other directly from the Bible in an inductive and participatory way together in small groups to live a life of daily obedient discipleship by relying on the Holy Spirit. Through this Discovery Bible Study course that focuses on obedience and reproduction, every member is equipped to serve as a leader in various types of small groups, including churches, missional groups, and cell groups.

Gospel Conversations Training Six-week Seminar

It is a mission education training program that divides the Gospel Conversations Training into 6 sessions for local churches. Over 6 sessions of 100 minutes each, the believers are trained, and practiced to begin the discipleship life in their own life. Presenting the vision of the Kingdom Multiplication movement, 4 1 1 training, finding a person of peace, B.L.E.S.S. (Care•Prayer•Share), Four Responses, evangelism practice (outreach), Harvest Diamonds, Discovery Bible study, etc., are the exercises that equip the members of the local church so that every believer can begin the life of the kingdom of God.

Canada Mosaic College 12

Life As Mission Basic School (B.L.E.S.S. Seminar)

5 Missional Practices (B.L.E.S S.) over a period of 6 weeks to help local churches transform into missional churches, and how the believers will live their missional lives together ecclesiastically on their own fields of life is a mission education training program to learn and train. It is a training that corresponds to the practical aspects of the missional life that reflects on the life of the B.L.E.S.S.er who is a blessing to all the nations and equips all believers to apply it specifically to their own lives by reflecting on the life of Jesus.

Friendship First Course

6-week mission education and training course that equips and trains local church members to befriend the Muslims who have come to our place and preach the Gospel of Christ. Through this course, trainees will not only understand the theological, historical, cultural, and communication barriers that exist between Muslims and Christians, but will also learn and master how to share and nurture the Gospel with our Muslim friends through field experiences such as mosque visits.

ADVANCE PROGRAM For Ethnic Pastors and Minister

Gateway Seminary's 2-year Advanced Program in the U.S. is a program in partnership with Harvest Connections to train leaders to handle church planting and ministry among ethnic minorities. For those who have successfully completed 8 courses in 3 credits each over a 2-year period, this is a diploma program certified by the cmca and harvest connection with gateway seminary as lay pastors and ministers.

Life As Mission School

8-week mission education and training program for local churches with Christopher Wright's "Mission of God's People" as the main textbook. LAMs, which will bring a paradigm shift in understanding mission, conclude with trainees writing and presenting their own missional life plan, helping the believers share the theological foundations for the local church's move toward a missional church.

Mosaic Ministry Discipleship School

It consists of a 7 week + 1 day retreat with mission education and training that introduces diaspora multiethnic ministry according to Mosaic principles to local churches and allows local church members to experience the realities of Mosaic ministry to participate in the CMCA's ministry. Meeting with church leaders of each ethnic church will not only give you an understanding of their culture and religious background, but you will also learn how to reach out to your neighbors in each religion and culture.

Mosaic Urban Missionary One-year Certificate Program

Taught in partnership with the TIM Center, an Intercultural Ministry Centre at Tyndale University, the Lay Missionary Training Course (2 semesters a year, 4 courses each of 3 credits, a total of 12 credits) is a mission education and training course for Korean believers who will devote themselves to the CMCA's ethnic church planting ministries, international student ministries, refugee ministries, and other urban mission ministries through Bible Courses 2 and Mission Courses 2. Graduates who complete this course will be certified as urban missionaries by the CMCA and TIM centers and sent to local churches and, at their option, will be part of the CMCA as well as various mission organizations such as SIM, IN-TERSERVE, etc., and will work with their churches on local missions.

To educate and train ethnic church leaders in partnership with Gateway Seminary & Harvest Connection at the Advance Program of Gateway Seminary, providing the five ethnic interns for missions and pastoral ministry, three Bengali brothers Mamun, Philip, Chinmoy, Persian sister N and Persian brother John, with the necessary strength, wisdom and finances in completing the 2-year program; Lead each of them to start their own ministry as intern pastors and missionaries; Canada Mosaic College can be built for the multiethnic Mosaic ministries in Toronto in the future. Please grant enough time, finance and wisdom to the 30 urban missionary candidates of the Mosaic Missionary Certificate Program(1 year, 4 subjects, 12 credits) in partnering with Tyndale Intercultural Ministries Centre. Help us to bear much fruits through Gospel Conversations Training in May 21st.
